





2021 International Fire Code 505.1 Address Identification

It is important to have a visible address on your home or business to ensure that Police/Fire/Ambulance services can quickly come to aid in an emergency. International Fire Code 505.1 requires all new and existing buildings to display address identification.

The identification must:

- · Be legible.
- Be placed in a position visible from the street/road fronting the property.
- Contrast with their background.
- Shall be Arabic numbers or alphabetical letters, numbers shall not be spelled out.
- Shall not be less than four (4) inches high, with a minimum stroke width of 1/2 inch.

First Construction Contract Awarded

The work to bring Lake Michigan water to the Grand Prairie Water Commission (GPWC)communities is progressing with the design work and gearing up for construction. The GPWC Board of Commissioners approved a contract



for the first construction project. Michels Trenchless, Inc. was selected from three bids received and has been awarded a contract in the amount of \$31.3 million.

The work they will perform includes a tunnel extension that will connect the Chicago water system to a new pump station. This will allow water to be transported to the Grand Prairie Water Commission communities. The 520-foot-long tunnel consists of a 10-foot diameter pipe and this work is expected to begin soon.

The mission of the Grand Prairie Water Commission is to provide a sustainable, reliable, and high-quality water supply for the member communities by 2030 and beyond in order to support public health, safety, economic interests, and quality of life. We will keep you updated on the GPWC and what it means to your community. You can also learn more at the commission website at www.gpwc-il.org.

Can We Talk About Self-Awareness?

If my life were a YouTube video, I fear there would be many times that, if you were viewing the video, you would wonder, "How could someone be so lacking in self-awareness?"

Like that time I lost it heading north on I-55 because my dear wife made a few comments on my driving. (Some of you know that story. If you do, you have my permission to laugh!) Basically, I drive like "grandpa" (I am a grandpa, so I can say that) in the neighborhood. But once on the highway, it's Nascar time! (Disclaimer: that is not a confession and speeds in excess of posted limits may or may not have been reached.)

During the drive Ruth made some comments on my driving that I chose to interpret as critical and negative. I responded with... well... let's say I was not the best version of myself. After a few exits passed by, somewhere near the 294 interchange, my frustration culminated with me yelling at her, saying, "Do you want to drive? DO. YOU. WANT. TO. DRIVE? This is A LEGITAMATE QUESTION!" (Caps added because I was yelling.)

I was blaming her for my feelings. I was choosing to react instead of choosing to listen to her concens. In other words, I did not pause long enough to ask: "How is my wife experiencing me? How do my words, my attitude, my chosen response to whatever she brings to

my attention make her feel? And what does all of that say about me?" Are you willing to ask those questions? Not married? Instead of wife, then sub in what fits: son, brother, co-worker, friend, daughter, neighbor, uncle, etc. It is humbling to ask. It might even be painful to receive the answers to those questions. But, it will go a long way toward bringing peace, understanding and health to you and your relationships. 


