NEW PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE PLACED OVER DUPAGE RIVER, LINKING COMMUNITIES

Locals have a major new milestone to celebrate this week. On August 18, 2026, crews officially set a brand-new pedestrian bridge into place over the DuPage River, marking a massive leap forward for a multi-year project to connect the neighboring communities of Channahon and Minooka.

The structural installation along McEvilly Road is the crowning jewel of a joint multi-use path initiative spearheaded by both villages. Positioned near the local boat launch, the span is designed to bridge the final gap between the two communities' independent trail systems, creating a seamless, safe pipeline for walkers, runners, and cyclists.



Beyond simply linking the two towns, the new infrastructure unlocks broader regional access. Trail users will soon be able to transition smoothly from local municipal paths directly onto the historic, expansive I&M Canal State Trail network. By eliminating the need to navigate busy vehicular roadways, local officials note the bridge fulfills a long-held vision for safer, healthier, and more interconnected regional recreation.

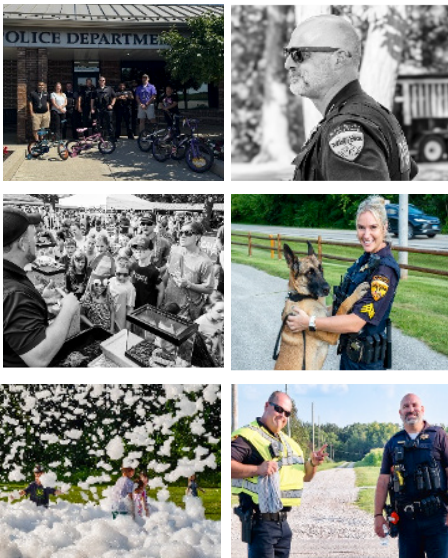
Chaplain's Corner

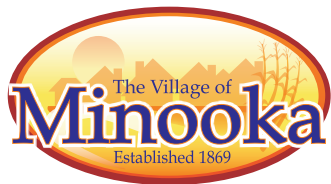
