Governor Pritzker visited Minooka on October 15th to celebrate a major milestone in the Reimagining Electric Vehicles tax credit program, administered by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. Innovative Rail Technologies and Motive Power Resources have expanded their Industrial Drive facility, where 100% battery-electric, Illinois-built locomotives will be manufactured and distributed. Pictured: Governor Pritzker, Motive Power employees, and local Illinois suppliers involved in the locomotive assembly process. **The first train built through this program will be delivered to Fort Hood, Texas, where it will be used by the U.S. Army.**



RECREATIONAL VEHICLE STORAGE:

Village ordinance states that from October 30th until May 1st, recreational vehicles including boats, personal watercraft, travel trailers, campers, motorhomes, and other summer recreation items must be moved to an interior side yard, rear yard, or to a fully enclosed building so long as the entire area under the vehicle is open, impervious, and constructed of a hard, dustless material, such as concrete, asphalt, or brick pavers. The surface must be capable of supporting the weight of the vehicle, and access to the front/side yard must meet these same requirements. This must be no closer than five (5) feet to the property lines. Recreational vehicles cannot be parked in front yards, corner lot side yards, front yard driveways, or any public roadway or right of way.

9-1-24: PROHIBITED PARKING DURING SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS:

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle on any highway, street, or alley within the village when snow shall have accumulated to a depth of two inches (2") or more on such highway, street, or alley. It shall be unlawful to so park from the time of such accumulation until the snow has been removed. In addition to all other remedies, every person who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with this section shall be sentenced as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code for each offense. Each occurrence shall constitute a separate offense. Members of the police department are hereby authorized to cause any vehicle parked in violation of this section to be removed from the highway, street, or alley, at the expense of the owner of the vehicle, pursuant to applicable statutes. (Ord. 2011-29, 12-20-2011)

NEWS FROM WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT



VILLAGE OF MINOOKA ELECTRIC SCOOTER & ELECTRIC BIKE RULES



The Village of Minooka is prioritizing education and encourages responsible electric scooter & bike use to help protect all roadway users. Please ride smart, stay alert and do your part to keep Minooka safe.

ELECTRIC SCOOTER

- A device weighing less than 100 pounds, with 2 or 3 wheels, handlebars, and a floorboard that can be stood upon while riding, that is solely powered by an electric motor and human power.

ELECTRIC BIKE CLASSIFICATIONS:

- Class 1: 20mph Max: Pedal assisted, no assistance without pedaling
- Class 2: 20mph Max, throttle assisted, can be ridden without pedaling
- Class 3: 28mph Max: Pedal assisted/optional throttle, no assistance without pedaling.

ELECTRIC SCOOTER LAWS

- Must be 18 years of age (Illinois State Law)
- May not be operated in an area with a posted speed limit in excess of 35mph
- The Village does not have authority to adopt local regulations less restrictive than the state law.
- Obey the Rules of the Road

ELECTRIC BIKE LAWS

- No age requirements for Class 1 or Class 2 electric bicycles.
- Persons under the age of 16 may NOT ride a "class 3" e-bike.
- Classification label must be affixed.
- Obey the Rules of the Road

VILLAGE ORDINANCE FOR ELECTRIC SCOOTERS & ELECTRIC BIKES

- Electric bicycles and electric scooters are allowed to be ridden on bicycle paths.
- Electric bicycles and electric scooters are not allowed on sidewalks.
- Electric Bicycles, Electric Scooters, and Gas Bicycles shall be prohibited from being ridden on the street or sidewalk on Mondamin Street in the location from Wabena Avenue to the alley located west of Massasoit Street.

PENALTIES

- Any person who violates the electric scooter or electric bicycle ordinance shall be subject to the following fines:
 - First offense: Sixty dollars (\$60.00).
 - Second offense: One hundred twenty dollars (\$120.00).
 - Third offense: Two hundred forty dollars (\$240.00).

ELECTRIC SCOOTER SAFETY REMINDERS

- Wear a helmet
- Look both ways before riding through any kind of intersection
- Walk your e-scooter in crowded areas.
- Avoid distractions

ELECTRIC BIKE SAFETY REMINDERS

- Before riding your e-bike, please make sure that all safety and mechanical equipment is working properly.
- Wear your helmet.
- When riding at night, please make sure you are using the correct equipment.


